How it all Began


To understand the mission of GWI, we must go back to 1948 when a

Swiss businessman, Jean André, visited Germany after World War II. His heart was broken at the sight of so many homeless children wandering the streets.

In response, he brought a group of 120 German orphans to Switzerland for the summer.

They were well fed, cared for and learned how deeply God loved and valued them.

This first group of children returned to their homeland refreshed and better equipped to become all God intended.



Values

GWI's message and actions are centered on God's love for all children among the nations without distinction of any kind.

Our values and our teachings are based solely on the Holy Bible.

Every child is given the opportunity to accept God's saving grace through Jesus Christ.

Context

In most of the countries GWI serves, children are deeply scarred by war, poverty, addiction, divorce, violence and poor education. In some cases, parents move elsewhere to find work leaving their children to fend for themselves.

GWI also cares for children in stable countries such as France, Spain, Switzerland, etc.

Activities

Our activities are enjoyed in a peaceful environment and designed to nurture each child spiritually, emotionally and physically.

This atmosphere of Christ-like love, fosters healthy relationships and opens children to faith in God.

2020-2023 Strategy

GWI's goal is to reach 5 million children in 2023. In view of this, we are professionalizing our ministry in every country.

Chloé*, age 16, has been completely deaf in her left ear since childhood. The hearing in her right ear is severely impaired but has been significantly improved through the use of a special hearing aid.

"Since childhood, my family and I have gone to Christian camps together and they helped me make friends. This summer is only the second time I've gone to a youth camp on my own.

At the beginning, it was very difficult for me to be around so many young people by myself, because I'm very shy. But after sharing my testimony at one of our meetings, I felt a lot more comfortable and outgoing. This encouraged me so much!

We were so deeply moved to see first-hand how God's love changed the hearts of these precious children.

Receiving Power to Live

Anastassiya*, age 14

From the first time we saw Anastassiya it was obvious that she was struggling. Even though she was already extremely thin, she couldn't finish even the smallest portion of food and was nauseated afterward. The camp director and counselors recognized Anastassiya's problem and reached out to help her.

Anastassiya remembers, "They didn't just want to educate me, but also tried to understand what was behind my eating disorder. I told them it was because my older brothers used to call me a 'fat lady', so I decided to lose weight and then I couldn't stop. After long conversations and prayer, I began to eat and take part in the games.

Two days later, I accepted Christ into my heart, because I realized that God loves me no matter what other people say. God not only saved my life physically at this camp, but even more importantly, He saved my soul. Now my heart's desire is to go to church and grow in my faith."



GWI FINANCIAL OVERVIEW - 2019


TOTAL REVENUES 2019 \$ 4,716,238 (CHF 4,686,316)




TOTAL EXPENSES 2019 \$ 4,675,359 (CHF 4,645,696)
